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April – The outline of the building is emerging!




April – Transition Preparations

- 7 Keep emergency phone numbers & some spare change in your bag.
- 8 If nobody is home when you finish school, make sure you have a key.
- 9 If you take medicine or use an inhaler, make sure you pack it in your bag.
- 10 Bring your completed transition workbook on your first day.
